Draft Bluewater Lake State Park Management Plan Follow-up Public Meeting Scheduled

Thoreau, NM – As a result of issues raised during two public meetings to consider the draft park management plan for Bluewater Lake State Park, New Mexico State Parks is holding a third public meeting on July 10, 2014, to allow for further input and discussion regarding the plan.

The initial meeting to solicit public input was held on May 29, 2014. As a result of concerns raised at the initial meeting, EMNRD Department Secretary F. David Martin and State Parks Director Tommy Mutz held special second public meeting with State Senator George Muñoz on June 30, 2014, where about 90 people gathered to express ideas and concerns about the proposed management plan.

For the upcoming third public meeting, State Park officials will present revisions to the plan in response to comments received during the public comment period. State Parks Division Director Tommy Mutz and staff will be present to update the public on the status of the Las Tusas Recreation Area and other management plan considerations.
