Dust Bowl Marathon at Clayton Lake State Park

Clayton, NM – Join runners from across the USA and around the world at Clayton Lake State Park for the Dust Bowl Marathon on March 26. Start time for the race is 6:30 a.m.

The race is entirely within Clayton Lake State Park, with views of the lake and world renowned dinosaur tracks. Runners will repeat the short 1.5 mile course by running the necessary laps to get the required marathon or half marathon.

Clayton Lake State Park is day five and the last stop of the Dust Bowl Mainly Marathon Series that begins in Texas on March 22 and goes through Oklahoma, Kansas and Colorado.

“We’re thrilled our park is part of this running series and community event,” said Park Manager Charles Jordan. “Families, friends, and others not participating in the event can still come out and enjoy all that the park has to offer.”

The registration for a full marathon is \$140; half marathon is \$120. Packets will be available one hour before the race. Active Military and members will receive a \$10 discount.
