Hyde State Park Management Plan Amendment for The Construction of Three Yurts *Public Meeting Scheduled for May 14, 2015*

Santa Fe, NM – New Mexico State Parks invites citizens to a public meeting to comment on a proposed amendment to the Hyde Memorial State Park management plan. This amendment will enable State Parks to build and rent three yurts in the park in order to enhance visitor enjoyment of the park. The yurts would be located on the west side of Hyde Park Road in a camp loop with two existing sites that are accessed by an unpaved road. The yurts would be 20 feet in diameter and each would have a door, three windows, and a skylight. In addition, one of the new yurts will be ADA accessible.

The public meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 14th, 2015 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Hyde Memorial State Park Lodge. The meeting will include a visit to the proposed site where the yurts would be built. Verbal comments on the plan amendment will be accepted at the public meeting.
