## **Fenton Lake State Park Closed to Ice Fishing**

**Fenton Lake, NM** – Effective immediately, ice fishing and other activities on the ice at Fenton Lake State Park are closed. New Mexico State Parks, in conjunction with the NM Department of Game and Fish, announced the closure of Fenton Lake to ice fishing and other on ice activities due to recent warm weather that has reduced the thickness and conditions of the ice.

State Parks staff will continue to monitor the ice conditions and keep the public informed about the status through their website. Fenton Lake State Park continues to remain open for camping and other activities.
