Notice of Filing of Permit Renewal Application in accordance with the requirements of 19 NMAC 8.2 Section 1100.A. of the New Mexico Mining Commission's Surface Coal Mining Regulations.

Chevron Mining Inc. (Chevron) herewith gives notice of filing of a permit renewal application for the Ancho/Gachupin-Brackett Surface Mines Permit #2017-02, located approximately 35 miles west of Raton on Highway 555, four miles south of the Colorado state line.

The permit renewal, which is designated "Renewal "2017-02" focuses on the reclamation and post mine land use associated with the Ancho/Gachupin-Brackett Surface Mines Permit. Mining at the Ancho/Gachupin-Brackett Surface Mines ceased in 2002. The renewal also describes the current bond release status.

In accordance with the previously cited regulation, Chevron states:
