**Case No. 15487: Joint Application for Rehearing of Order No. R-14164-D, Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Through the Supervisor of District II for an Emergency Order Suspending Certain Approved Applications for Permits to Drill, and for Adoption of Special Rules for Drilling in Certain Areas for the Protection of Fresh Water, Chaves and Eddy Counties, New Mexico.** The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, upon a Joint Application for Rehearing filed by parties appearing in the case, will consider proposed amendments to the Special Provisions for A Selected Area Of The Roswell Basin adopted under Order No. R-14164-D. The proposed amendments will (a) limit the Designated Area identified in adopted 19.15.39.11(A) as subject to the Special Provisions to only the area where both aquifers exist as recognized by the Office of the State Engineer and other published studies, plus a one mile buffer zone; and (b) modify the language in adopted 19.15.39.11(C)(2) to clarify when the surface casing string may be set “not more than 50 feet above the first show of hydrocarbons on a mud log...”.
