A party who plans on using projection equipment at a hearing must contact Florene Davidson, seven (7) business days prior to the hearing, requesting the use of the projection equipment. ***Application of Kaiser-Francis Oil Company for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.*** Kaiser-Francis Oil Company seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2 SE/4 of Section 20 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit.
