Hyde Memorial State Park Mitigation Treatment Completed

Santa Fe, NM – New Mexico State Forestry (NMSF) crews successfully completed a prescribed pile burn project at Hyde Memorial State Park on Tuesday. NMSF and the New Mexico State Parks Division partnered on the wildfire mitigation initiative.

Due to favorable weather conditions, resources treated an estimated 40 acres. Beneficial wind currents minimized the smoke impact in the area, and no road closures were necessary. Crews from the Returning Heroes Wildland Firefighters Program will monitor the site for another three days.

The pile burn was part of ongoing treatment that began last year at the park.
