State Forestry Division Holds Annual End-of-Season Seedling Sale

Who: New Mexico State Forestry Conservation Tree Seedling Program

What: Special on-site sale of remaining tree seedlings

When: Thursday, May 1, and Friday, May 2, 2014 – 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Where: The State Forestry Seedling Tree House, 3250 Calle Princessa Juana, Santa Fe, NM 87507

Why: New Mexico State Forestry will hold a special two-day sale at its Seedling Tree House in Santa Fe, offering a wide range of tree seedlings, usually available only in lots of 25 or greater to owners of an acre or more of land.

The bare-root tree species offered at this year's sale include: native plum, hybrid cottonwood, woods rose, wax currant, and black locust.

Other species in small containers and various quantities include: Afghanistan pine, Arizona cypress, Arizona walnut, Austrian pine, Arizona sycamore, bigtooth maple, Engelmann spruce, black willow, Goodding's black willow, bluestem willow, thinleaf alder, redosier dogwood, blue spruce, bristlecone pine, Douglas fir, hoptree, lacebark elm, limber pine, mountain snowberry, New Mexico foresteria, piñon; Rio Grande cottonwood, Plains cottonwood, eastern redcedar, four-wing saltbush, chamisa, winterfat, white fir, smooth sumac, southwestern white pine, ponderosa pine, desert willow, and Scots pine.

Bare-root are \$20 for a bundle of 25, and small containers \$1.00 each (minimum of 10) - mix and match.

During the sale dates, all trees are first come, first served and cash and carry. Please note that UPS shipping will not be available. On-line orders will not be accepted for this sale.
