# Eagle Nest Lake State Park Closed to Ice Fishing

**Eagle Nest, NM** – Eagle Nest Lake is closed to ice fishing and other activities on the ice because of recent warm weather that caused rapidly deteriorating and unsafe ice conditions. The closure is effective today, March 2, 2016. The lake is still mostly covered with ice, but open water is beginning to appear in some areas. The lake may reopen to ice fishing if conditions improve. Anglers are advised to contact the state park for current fishing and ice conditions at (575) 377-1594. Eagle Nest Lake State Park will remain open for camping and other activities.
