Eagle Nest Lake State Park Marina Way Construction Complete

Eagle Nest, NM –The Village of Eagle Nest has finished paving Marina Way, the main entrance into Eagle Nest Lake State Park. Paving the roadway provides better access to the park and minimizes dust and traffic issues for surrounding businesses and neighbors. Marina Way is now open for two-way traffic into and out of the park. As a result of the completion of the paving project on Marina Way, the Fisherman's Lane access will now be used **ONLY** as a park exit. Thus, Marina Way becomes the only way to enter Eagle Nest Lake State Park.

As a reminder, all visitors to the park must pay a \$5 day use fee. This fee is applicable during the fireworks display to be held on Independence Day. Park officials encourage visitors to enjoy the display and remind everyone that personal fireworks and glass containers are prohibited in the park.
