5th Annual Spring Trout Derby at Oasis State Park

Portales, NM – Come away with fish, cash and great memories at Oasis State Park's 5th Annual Spring Trout Derby on March 22 and 23 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

"Our fishing derby is a great time for families to come out and enjoy the park," said Oasis State Park Manager Jim Whary. "It's also a great way to learn how to fish."

The lake has been stocked with trout, and prizes will be awarded for catching specially tagged fish. Win between \$5 and \$100! Here's the catch: the trout must still have the tag intact to collect the prize. Door prizes will also be drawn every hour during derby hours.

A \$5 derby entrance fee covers both days. A daily \$5 per vehicle park entrance fee for non-annual permit holders applies.
