Two New Mexico State Parks Announce Seasonal Schedule Changes

SANTA FE, NM – Mesilla Valley Bosque State Park in Mesilla and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial State Park in Angel Fire are announcing schedule changes to accommodate seasonal visitor use at the parks and to effectively manage staffing.

Mesilla Valley Bosque State Park Gate and Visitor Center will be closed on Mondays and Tuesdays from December 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013. The park trails will still be open to walk-in visitation.

The *Visitor Center at Vietnam Veterans Memorial State Park* will also be closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from November 1 through March 31. The grounds and the chapel will remain open every day. Please monitor winter weather on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, as parking lots may be inaccessible.

These parks will still conduct regular programs and special events. The seasonal schedule will be implemented to ensure minimal impact to visitor services.
