Fenton Lake To Remain Closed Due To Extreme Fire Danger

Santa Fe, NM – State Park officials announced today that Fenton Lake State Park will remain closed indefinitely due to extreme fire danger. The park was initially closed on June 4th due to safety issues related to helicopters accessing the lake for water to fight the Thompson Ridge Fire in the Santa Fe National Forest.

The New Mexico State Parks Division is working collaboratively with the Santa Fe National Forest to determine when conditions will be safe enough to reopen.
