Public Meeting will be held to Review Draft Management Plan for Bottomless Lakes State Park

Santa Fe, NM – New Mexico State Parks will be hosting a public meeting on Wednesday, November 2, 2016 at 6 p.m. to comment on the Draft Park Management Plan for Bottomless Lakes State Park at Eastern New Mexico University's Roswell Campus, Union Building, Room 110, located at 48 University Boulevard in Roswell.

The plan proposes a variety of improvements to Bottomless Lakes State Park as well as management recommendations. Improvements include updating the park's water system, improving ADA accessibility in areas throughout the park, making repairs and upgrades to various structures, constructing a multipurpose building at the park, and adding trails and signs. The plan also includes a review of existing park resources and proposes improvements for the next five years.

Copies of the Draft Plan are available for review at Bottomless Lakes State Park Visitor Center, located at 545 A Bottomless Lakes Rd. Roswell, NM, the State Parks Division Regional Office at 324 S. Canyon St. Carlsbad, NM or on-line at www.nmparks.com.

Each state park is required to have a current park management plan. The objective is to provide direction for the management and development of the park to protect park resources and enhance recreational opportunities.
