### Triathlon at Ute Lake State Park

**Logan, NM** – You’ve been training all year. Swimming, biking, cardio....now you’re ready to compete in *Ute the Man! Sprint Triathlon – 2014*, hosted by Ute Lake State Park on Saturday, August 2, with the first race wave beginning at 7:30 a.m.

“We are always happy to host athletic, community events at State Parks,” said Park Superintendent Rodney Paris. “Participants not only get great exercise outdoors, they get to see more of the park and hopefully come back for more fun, outdoor recreation.”
