Hyde Memorial State Park Hosts a Series of Wildflower Walks

SANTA FE, NM – New Mexico State Parks Division together with local naturalist, Ken Collins, will host a series of wildflower walks at Hyde Memorial State Park. The walks are scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on July 29th, August 5th and August 12th 2012.

“Monsoon rains bring mountain wildflowers,” said Tommy Mutz, Director for New Mexico State Parks Division. “Join us at Hyde Memorial State Park for a glorious morning walk.”

Along the two mile walk, you will learn to identify and understand the unique qualities of plants and wildflowers found in the area. The walks depart from the visitor center. Wear sturdy shoes and bring your own water and a snack for a morning jaunt in the mountains.

A \$5 per vehicle day use fee applies. Day use permits may be obtained at the self-pay station adjacent to the visitor center.

Hyde Memorial State Park is nestled in the foothills of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains just eight miles east of Santa Fe via NM State Highway 475.
