State Solicits Public Comment on Sampling and Analysis Plan for Proposed Cebolleta Uranium Mining Operation

Santa Fe – The Mining and Minerals Division is soliciting public comments on a sampling and analysis plan submitted by Neutron Energy, Inc., for the proposed Cebolleta uranium mine. The plan will guide the collection of baseline data that can be used in a permit application for a new mine. The proposed Cebolleta Mine would be located on private property within the Cebolleta Land Grant in Cibola County, approximately 4 miles east of the village of Seboyeta, and 17 miles north of Laguna, New Mexico.

“The sampling and analysis plan is the first step in the development of a permit application for a new mining operation. The collection of baseline data is an essential component for a permit application,” stated Mining and Minerals Division Director Fernando Martinez. “Public comments on the plan submitted by June 8th will be provided to the applicant to assist in their preparation of a permit application.”

A sampling and analysis plan will guide the collection of baseline data on climate, air quality, geology, topography, soils, vegetation, wildlife, cultural values, surface and groundwater, and other environmental parameters related to the site. The baseline data must be included in any application for a new mining operation.
