## Trail Description:

This network of trails provides a unique experience of Ute Lake State Park as it winds through the desert, in and out of arroyos, and along the edge of a narrow canyon of fractured bedrock. There are several spur trails that will take you to benches overlooking the lake. Create a 2 mile loop between the Logan and Rogers Trailheads.



## Precautions:

It can be hot, dry, and sunny. Please be prepared with plenty of water. Use caution at the canyon overlook, especially with children and dogs.

## Park Rules:

The trail is within the park fee area. Vehicles must display a valid park permit, which can be purchased at a self-pay station or the visitor center.

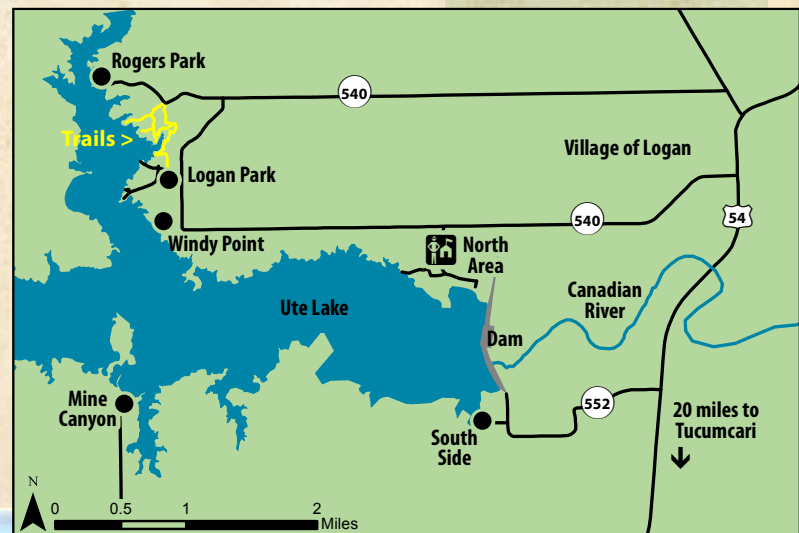
